Code of Conduct for Members, Guests and Visitors

Elfordleigh Golf Club is committed to providing a safe environment for members, visitors and staff.

All members and visitors are reminded that an acceptable standard of behaviour must be maintained at all times, both on the course, practice areas and in the clubhouse. Upon payment of membership fees or green fees, members and guests/visitors are bound by the standards set out in the Code of Conduct.

In the Clubhouse:

- No foul or offensive language to be used
- Be respectful of other guests/visitors and staff
- Any form of discrimination, harassment or intimidation is regarded as unacceptable behaviour

On the Course:

- Adhere to the dress code
- Avoid slow play
- Repair pitch marks
- Rake or smooth bunkers
- Replace divots
- No foul or offensive language
- No misuse of equipment eg golf clubs, signage, tee markers, flags rakes etc
- Be respectful of other players and staff members
